



1. Load Image - Select an image file from your Mac. All images will be converted to Adobe RGB colour space on loading.
2. Open Project
3. Save Project
4. Export Image - this allows an image of the current layout to be saved as a static image ie. all swatches gridlines and adjustments will be saved into a single .PNG image file. NB. This is not the same as saving the project for later use!
5. Swatch position Left/Right
6. Swatch Position Top/Bottom
7. Neutral Background Color - Black/Grey/White
8. Reset Swatch Size
9. Sample Line Color
10. Full Screen
11. Zoom Extents
12. Reshape Window to match screen
13. Current monitor screen ratio
14. Value - Switch off colour
15. Contrast
16. Chroma - reduce or intensify the image saturation
17. Warmth - Increase or reduce the image color temperature
18. Big Shapes - Reduce image to essential shapes
19. Squint - Blur image, 4 levels
20. Grid On/Off
21. Centre Grid on image
22. Autogrid - paletteQ calculates the smallest number of squares that fit exactly into the image
23. Adjust grid density
24. Centrelines
25. Rule of Thirds
26. Current grid size (width x height)
27. Current grid ratio (width x height)
28. Grid colour - Red, Green or Blue
29. Grid line thickness - Fine, Medium or Thick
30. Hide control panel
31. Hide grid
32. Hide swatches
33. Control panel colour relates to image
34. Load last state before quitting
35. Trackball option for moving image
